

# Analysis Dutch survey

This is the analysis from the Dutch survey results.

A thing in the beginning of the survey that is attracting attention straight away is the age, a lot of people were 12-14 years old when the survey was taken. I expected more older people or children. As it turns out, that was incorrect.

Another interesting thing is 87% has a non-migrational background, which is surprising, because I thought we had more immigrants than that. To be honest, I think that not a lot of immigrants have seen or even heard about the survey.

A really outstanding point is also the religion. The religion in the Netherlands is nothing at all 72%, 10% chose no answer and the remaining 18% is divided between Roman Catholic, Protestant, Islam and other Christian denominations. So the teens from the Netherlands don't really care at about religion all as it seems...

We are quite satisfied with democracy. 61% voted 3 out of 4 to be precise. So not everyone is completely satisfied. Things can always become better. A thing that was striking in the "next door"-part was that averagely speaking, we don't really care. Except for the elderly people, it seems that we would really like to have them next door.

Also a notable thing, Dutch people want/ are living life to the fullest. 63% voted for 4 out of 4. We like parties and other exciting things to do. Probably something that's in our blood.

Same story for a good family life. Even though we're always on school or upstairs, we seem to enjoy our family life. (64%)

Now when we look at the part about a trustworthy partner, 79% voted for 5 out of 5 and at the part about good friends even 80%!

When the question about belief in god passed, 60% filled in a 0 out of 5, That means that not a lot of (young) people care about God or a spiritual being in the Netherlands.

Another remarkable thing is that 69% from the dutch people voted 5 out of 5 for the need of trustworthy people in their lives. We need people we can talk to whenever we are in need of it.

A rather surprising one was the traditional family part, where 49% voted 0 out of 5, strange. Because our country is quite full of traditions. This part was shocking, because 79% (!) voted 0 out of 5 to allow homo's to raise a child/ children.

51% voted 5 out of 5 for men being capable of raising children and taking care of them.

4 other outstanding facts are:

- Transgenders are ok, 74% voted 5 out of 5.
- Right to fall in love, 78% voted 5 out of 5. Which is weird, because a 100% should have the right to fall in love.
- No sex without marriage 56% voted 0 out of 5. In the Netherlands there are a lot of one night stands or couples that are not married who have sex. So, it's quite normal here.
- And my body, my decision 71% voted 5 out of 5.

The last one, 68% would raise their child more or less the same then their parents did.
